- 1 All exhibits must be made, grown or created by the exhibitor as appropriate. Only one entry per exhibitor per class. They must not have been entered in any of our previous shows. **PLEASE NOTE: OPEN CLASSES MAY BE ENTERED BY VILLAGE RESIDENTS AS WELL AS NON-RESIDENTS.**
- 2 The hall will be open for staging from **6pm - 8pm on Friday 2nd August and from 7.30 am until 10am on Saturday 3rd August** when it must be closed for judging.
- 3 Entry fees for adults: 30p each for the first 10 classes then 15p for each class thereafter. 16 years and under - no fee.
- 4 **ENTRY FORMS MUST BE IN BY 6pm on TUESDAY 30th July**
- 5 Any contingency not provided for in the rules will be left to the discretion of the Committee. Except as otherwise provided for in the rules, the decision of the Judges is final.
- 6 No exhibit may be removed until after the presentations but before the raffle.

When staging your exhibits please do not touch any other exhibitor's exhibits or cards. Exhibits cannot be covered by Village Hall insurance.

OPEN CLASSES – VEGETABLES AND FLOWERS

(special award of £5 to the person exhibiting in most classes)

- 1 Three red beetroot – globe for colour – trimmed to 10-15cm (4-6")
- 2 Six runner beans
- 3 Ten dwarf beans
- 4 Longest runner bean
- 5 Three carrots – trimmed 7.5-10cm (3-4")
- 6 Three sticks of rhubarb
- 7 Five radishes – tops left on
- 8 Five onions – white
- 9 Five onions – red
- 10 Nine shallots – giant grown from bulbs – not doubles
- 11 Nine shallots – pickling size – grown from bulbs
- 12 Three courgettes
- 13 Two marrows – fit for table
- 14 One marrow – for weight
- 15 Five potatoes – of a named variety
- 16 A bulb of garlic
- 17 Five broad beans
- 18 Five potatoes – for weight
- 19 Five tomatoes – indoor – not miniature
- 20 Five tomatoes – miniature
- 21 Two cucumbers – any variety
- 22 Collection of vegetables – 4 varieties as per schedule for classes 1 -21.
Tray not to exceed 61 x 61cm (2ft x 2ft) external measurement
(Special Prizes – 1st £5 2nd £3 3rd £2)
- 23 Selection of not less than 5 salad crops (from tomatoes, cucumber, lettuce, beetroot, radish, pepper, onions, rocket, cress, carrots)
- 24 Five different herbs – cut or growing- using one or five pots/vases to display
- 25 One rose any variety
- 26 3 stems of hydrangea
- 27 Five dahlias – any variety/varieties
- 28 Vase of foliage – five stems, mixed varieties
- 29 Three roses - any colour/variety
- 30 Five stems of sweet pea – any colour/variety (can be single or mixed)
- 31 Five African marigold blooms
- 32 Vase of mixed annuals – 5 stems – any variety
- 33 Vase of mixed perennials (including shrubs) 5 stems – any variety
- 34 Fuchsia – pot not to exceed 25.5cm (10") internal measurement
- 35 Pelargonium pot plant
- 36 Pot plant for bloom
- 37 Pot plant for foliage only – including cacti and succulents
- 38 Hanging container of any plants
- 39 An arrangement of plant material – any container - 46cm (18") max. all dimensions.
- 40 Odd shaped vegetable or fruit

OPEN CLASSES – FLORAL ART (flower and foliage unless stated)

- 41 A foliage arrangement – 61cm (2ft) max. all dimensions. **First Prize £5**
- 42 An exhibit using a basket. – 61cm (2ft) max. all dimensions
- 43 An arrangement – All one colour – 61cm (2ft) max. all dimensions.
- 44 A Lunar Theme garden – 61cm (2ft) max. all dimensions
- 45 A petite exhibit in any type of container – 23cm (9") max. in all dimensions
- 46 A display of floating flowers/foilage in a bowl – 25.4 cm (10') max. diameter.

OPEN CLASSES – CONFECTIONERY – PRESERVES – LIQUEUR

(47–50) 227gm – 454gm (8oz –16oz) straight sided plain glass jars, screw tops only – dated.

- 47 Jar of jam – any variety
- 48 Jar of marmalade
- 49 Jar of chutney
- 50 Jar of fruit jelly

Note: Classes 51 to 66 may be cut open/tasted by the judge

- 51 Six cheese straws
- 52 Six pieces of gingerbread
- 53 Six rock cakes
- 54 Six handmade bread rolls – any flour type
- 55 Six sweet scones - any flavour (labelled)
- 56 Victoria sandwich – 18–20cm (7-8") cake tin – jam filling – sprinkling of sugar on top if desired
- 57 Fruit cake -
 - 340g (12oz) mixed fruit
 - 114g (4oz) sugar
 - 142ml (1/4pt) water
 - 170g (6oz) SR flour
 - 114g (4oz) butter or margarine
 - 1 egg

Place fruit, sugar, margarine and water in pan. Simmer slowly for 20mins. Allow to cool then add beaten egg and stir in flour. Turn into a greased or lined 15-18cm (6-7") round tin and bake for 1½ hours at 150C/300F or gas mark 2.

- 58 Lemon drizzle cake (made in a 2lb loaf tin).
- 59 Round of shortbread not to exceed 20cm (8")
- 60 Suffolk rusks – three tops and three bottoms
- 61 Five cupcakes decorated using a lunar/star theme
- 62 Treacle (Syrup) tart 15-20cm (6"– 8") diameter
- 63 Five chocolate brownies
- 64 Any homemade Swiss roll
- 65 Showstopper cake (decorated with a spaceship theme)
- 66 Any homemade liqueur

OPEN CLASSES - HANDICRAFTS

- 67 Hand knitted/crocheted item
- 68 An item of patchwork and/or quilting
- 69 Handicraft any medium **other than wood or metal**
- 70 Handicraft – **made from wood or metal**
- 71 A drawing – any medium
- 72 Painting – any medium. With mount or frame. Easel if desired.
- 73 An item of handmade ceramic
